•As with page numbers, paragraph numbers will act as a reference so you can easily refer to places in the text.

2. Circle

•Descriptive words and names of people, places and things.

•Vivid language, concrete nouns, names of characters, names of places, vocabulary,

word choice, diction.

3. Underline

•Descriptions, figurative language, or other information relevant to the reading

purpose.
