<p>Organization: The organizational structure of the paragraph begins with a thesis statement that showcases the central idea or them. The paragraph contains a minimum of two pieces of evidence. The student has explained how each piece of evidence fits the claim/thesis. Points: 5 ea. paragraph</p>			
<p>Voice: The write speaks directly to the reader in a manner that is individual, compelling, engaging, and that shows respect for the audience. Points: 5 ea. paragraph</p>			
<p>Word Choice: Words convey the intended message in a precise, interesting, and natural way. Points: 5 ea. paragraph</p>			
<p>Sentence Fluency: The writing has an easy flow, rhythm, and cadence. Sentences are well-constructed. There are no fragments or run-ons. Points: 5 ea. paragraph</p>			
<p>Conventions: The writer demonstrates a good grasp of the writing conventions of standard English. Very little editing needs to be done to share with an outside source. Points: 5 ea. paragraph</p>
