## Writing Prompts

Directions: Pick three of the following questions. Write an extended paragraph to answer each of them that contains a thesis statement, your ideas relating the text to the question, and text evidence. This is your summative grade for *Frankenstein*.

- 1. How has the creature changed during the selected text excerpt we have just read? What has contributed to these changes?
- 2. Is the creature ultimately responsible for how he has changed or should the cottagers assume some of the blame? If so, why? If not, why not?
- 3. Based on the pages just studied, does Victor Frankenstein hold any responsibility for the creature's current situation and state of mind? If so, why? If not, why not?
- 4. What qualities or characteristics would you now use to define a "monster"? At this point in the novel, would you characterize the creature as a monster or not? Use evidence from the text to support your response.
- 5. After examining this text excerpt, how does the fact that these sections are told from the creature's point of view impact how you "see" him and relate to him as a character?
